

# Maritime Archaeology Fieldwork Practicum

This is a practicum which provides students with opportunities to participate in the workplace environment. Occasionally, field work opportunities arise in which students may assist government agencies, consultancy firms, non-profit groups, or other universities. This practicum provides students with the ability to participate in these projects and receive one-on-one guidance and instruction with immediate feedback on their performance.

This practicum will allow students to put their theoretical learning into practice, develop a sense of the workplace, enhance their employment prospects through additional training, build a network of contacts and develop a range of personal and professional work skills.



The Lighthouse Archaeology Maritime Program (LAMP) is partnering with Flinders University to offer our second overseas practicum. Working with LAMP, students will conduct advanced underwater archaeology survey, remote sensing, position fixing, mapping, photography, recording, excavation and conservation.

The practicum is available to enrolled Flinders students as a graduate level unit of study in the Maritime Archaeology Program (ARCH8109 – 3 units). Other qualified participants may take part in the practicum on a short course basis. The practicum may be available under cross-institutional study arrangements (contact organizers for details). Short course participants are **not** enrolled

students of Flinders University and do not appear on the university's student system or receive academic transcripts. Participants who successfully complete the short course will receive a certificate of completion which states that the course is equivalent to the Flinders topic ARCH8109 and that the assessment requirements have been met.

The tuition fee will be AUD\$1375+ gst. There is an additional practicum fee of AUD\$700. This additional fee covers accommodation, local transport, dive equipment and tank fills, and most food. You will be responsible for your airfares to and from Florida, health insurance, and travel insurance. The university accepts no responsibility to provide financial support.
