Keynote Speaker Loriene Roy

Loriene Roy, President Elect of the ALA, is a Professor in the School of Information at the University of Texas at Austin. Her professional work focuses on library services for indigenous populations. She serves as Director of "If I Can Read, I Can Do Anything," a reading promotion program for schools on or near reservations. She teaches graduate courses in public librarianship, reference sources and services in the humanities and social sciences, and library instruction and information literacy. Her research also includes creating tribal college virtual libraries, virtual museums of indigenous material culture, and co-developing an intelligent agent for book recommending.

Directions

From the north: Take Exit 9 from Route 95 south to Route 4. Follow Route 4; it will merge into Route 1. Remain on Route 1 until you see the exit for Route 138 west, URI. Stay on Route 138 for about four miles and turn right onto Upper College Road at the second light.
