

PHILOSOPHY

The University of Rhode Island's Intramural Sports Program is coordinated by the Department of Recreational Services. Intramural sports are an integral part of campus life giving students, faculty, and staff the opportunity to come together for competition and camaraderie. The Intramural Sports staff invites you to get involved and be part of the action.

A variety of individual and team sports/activities are planned ranging from regular league competition to more informal tournament activities and one-day events which are intended to serve the varied interests of the URI community. No activity is too far-fetched or outrageous. The philosophy for Intramural Sports is to provide a little for everyone in order to get the most for all.

Participation in the Intramural program is voluntary. Injuries and their resulting costs are the responsibility of the participant. Each participant is advised to carry personal health and accident insurance.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

All participants are accountable for their actions in the program, regardless of participation level - competitive or recreational. Intramural Sports staff members are empowered to remove participants, coaches and/or spectators from any program event who display unsportsmanlike conduct or interfere with the staff's ability to perform their duties.

Team captains are responsible for the conduct of all individuals on their teams as well as their supporting personnel and spectators. Any ejections (individual or team) will be dealt with by the Coordinator of Intramural Sports and a disciplinary review board if necessary. A participant or team may not resume participation until a discipline review meeting has taken place.

AWARDS

Members of championship teams in all activities will receive Intramural champion t-shirts. One shirt will be awarded to each individual listed on the team roster who has played during the regular season.

EXTRAMURAL SPORTS

The Intramural Sports Program takes pride in allowing its participants to take part in extramural competition at the state, regional and national level in various sports as presented by NIRSA endorsed programs. In order to be eligible to participate at such competitions, participants must be full-time students at URI and participate in the Intramural Sports Program. The Intramural Sports Program encourages participants who are interested in representing URI Intramurals at a regional competition to submit a letter of interest to the Coordinator of Intramural Sports.

Contingent upon the number of sponsored competitions in any given year, participants will incur additional costs to participate in these optional events. Some subsidization by the Intramural Sports program **may be included**. Final decisions on participant eligibility (via participation and conduct in the IM program), trip costs, and arrangements are made by the Coordinator of Intramural Sports.

HOW TO REGISTER

Enter **ONLINE**. All entries must be submitted with the appropriate entry fee (s) at the required Captains meeting. **Submitting an entry form secures a spot for an individual or team, but it does not guarantee a spot on the playing schedule until completion of the appropriate Captains' meeting. Attendance is mandatory.**

GET ORGANIZED! REGISTER NOW!

At your Residence/Fraternity/Sorority:

- Select an IM Sports Athletic Representative.
- Select a central bulletin board and use it for Intramural Sports information.
- Update all residence/house members on upcoming IM Sports events.
- Recruit new team members - check with the IM Sports Office for Free Agents.
- Submit **ONLINE** team entries to the Intramural Sports Office with appropriate fee (s) paid by the required deadline date.
- Attend the Captains' meetings or designate a team rep. to do so.

NEED A TEAM? FREE AGENTS WANTED!!

If you can't get on a team or put together your own, sign up as a Free Agent **ONLINE**. Look for the specific Free Agent listing that you desire and register accordingly. The Intramural Sports Office will contact you if placement on a team is successful. **Be sure to attend the appropriate Captains' meeting - it increases your chances of getting on a team!!!**

PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY

The Intramural Sports Office does not assume responsibility for the eligibility of participants, but can assist team representatives with eligibility questions and interpretation. All individuals must have clearance through the Rec Services main office database; if not, he/she cannot participate in any Intramural Sports activities.

Students: All student participants (undergraduate/graduate) must be enrolled (full/part-time) at the University of Rhode Island and have paid the recreation fee in order to have access to the facilities.

Faculty & Staff: All participants must have paid the recreation fee in order to participate and have access to the facilities.

Intercollegiate Athletes: "Active" members of an intercollegiate team(s) are not eligible to participate in that sport or related activities. Any person that appears on the official team roster is considered to be part of that intercollegiate team.

Club Sport Athletes: A maximum of three (3) club sport members may participate on a roster for their specific or related sport.
