Directions: North Scituate Community House, 546 West Greenville Road, (Rte. 116):

From Route 295: take exit 6 and travel west on Route 6 into Scituate. Just after the Scituate IGA store (which will be on your right) you will come to the intersection of Route 6 and Danielson Pike. Bear to the right and stay on Route 6 until you come to the intersection of Route 116. Take a left onto Route 116 (this is West Greenville Road) and travel about ¼ mile. The North Scituate Community House will be on your right just before an historic church. Across the street is the North Scituate Village Green.
