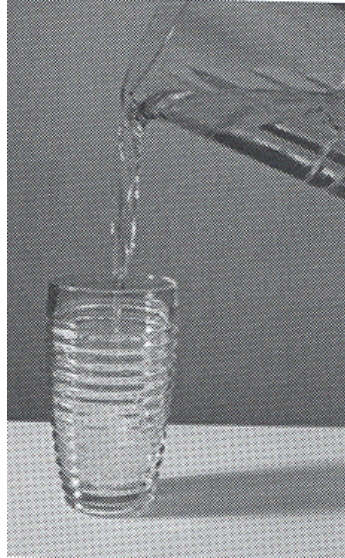


Get Involved!!
