Description:

Gain experience in environmental education in a tropical conservatory! The URI Learning Landscape Program is a two-hour environmental field trip program led by URI students and Master Gardeners around the Roger Williams Park Botanical Center in Providence. As an “Eco-Exploration” field trip leader, you will guide a group of elementary school children (grades K-5) through a series of hands-on learning stations. Topics include native mammals, insects and birds, seeds and plants, ecosystems, composting and recycling.

Requirements:

Coursework in science and/or education. Availability to attend at least 4 field trip dates (including one training session). Experience working with children recommended but not required. All student volunteers will attend a three-hour training session and act as a leader’s helper for 1-2 field trips, eventually gaining enough confidence to lead a group on their own.
