WHEN:

From **July 14th to July 31st 2009**, students partake in a Chinese learning experience that incorporates classroom instruction and scenic travel spots.

WHO:

- Has a U.S. Citizenship or Green Card
- Has an excellent academic record

ACTIVITIES:

Students will learn about various aspects of Chinese language and culture, including:
