Current State employees working in that job class or who have attained permanent status in it may apply without taking the exam. Candidates for the ENGINEER INTERN level must have a Bachelor or Master degree in Civil Engineering. Working with a DEP Engineer or Environmental Analyst, the ENGINEER INTERN will receive one to two years of on-the-job training in professional sanitary engineering involving municipal and privately owned wastewater treatment facilities. Successful completion of the Internship will be followed by appointment to the target class of SANITARY ENGINEER 1.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

This position is responsible for assisting in the review of planning, design and construction documents of municipal wastewater infrastructure projects through the Clean Water Fund, and conducting basic evaluation of public waterways' pollution sources. Duties may include:

- Assisting in the review and approval of municipal wastewater management planning documents related to wastewater treatment facilities, sanitary sewer systems, small community treatment systems, innovative and alternative treatment systems, and onsite septic systems;
- Assisting in the review and providing comments on design documents for any or all of the above systems;
- Investigating wastewater disposal problems;
- Interacting with local, state and federal government agencies regarding wastewater problems and proposed solutions; and
- Responding to municipal officials' and the general public's inquiries regarding environmental issues.

The PREFERRED CANDIDATE WILL HAVE:

- Academic training in civil, sanitary, environmental or chemical engineering with emphasis on courses in



sanitary engineering, soils engineering, wastewater management or construction management;

- Some experience with or exposure to the theories, principles and practices of environmental regulation specific to water or wastewater treatment;
- Some exposure to developing or evaluating technical reports and environmental assessments;
- Some experience with or exposure to reading, interpreting and utilizing construction drawings and plans, soil and sanitary surveys, aerial photos, topographic and other resource maps, technical charts, graphs, data tables;
- Ability to work with MS Word, spreadsheets and databases, statistical analysis, and GIS;
- Ability to utilize written and oral communication and interpersonal skills to address and confer effectively with peers, public officials and the general public.
