The Engineering Analysis Section of the Inland Water Resources Division is responsible for conducting technical reviews of engineering investigations of bridges and other hydraulic structures for the various land use permitting programs, including Inland Wetland and Watercourses, Stream Channel Encroachment Line, Water Diversion, Water Quality and Floodplain Management. The **CIVIL ENGINEER INTERN** will assist with:

- Conducting technical reviews of engineering investigations and studies pertaining to hydraulic and hydrologic characteristics of watersheds and of site development plans, proposals and permit applications for accuracy and environmental soundness (including assessing runoff conditions, sediment and erosion potential, water quality impacts, and flooding impacts);
- Evaluating the engineering components of permit applications related to dam safety, inland wetlands, stream channel encroachment lines, flood management, water quality certification and water diversion;
- Preparing reports;
- Conducting field investigations;
- Participating in public hearings.


- Knowledge of the principles and practices of drainage, water quality, flooding, dam safety, hydrology and hydraulics, soil and erosion control;
