

FINAL PROJECT

Overview – The final project will be 1-2 minutes in length. It may be a commercial, narrative, documentary, educational or marketing video. The final project must include the following:

1. An opening title using Live Type, Motion or Final Cut. Music and/or sound effects are optional.
2. All video must be produced by the student. No found video.
3. Proper lighting and audio must be used.
4. All video must be color corrected via Final Cut or Color.
5. All audio needs to be normalized and corrected for any deficiencies via Final Cut and/or Soundtrack Pro.
6. A treatment or script of the final project must be submitted to the instructor by March 10 for approval. Failure to do so without a valid excuse will affect your grade.
7. Final projects needs to be submitted on miniDV and DVD no later than April 28. Failure to submit by this date without a valid excuse will affect your grade.

The final project should take 25-30 hours to complete. Do not wait till the last minute to begin work.

The instructor will be available one hour before class to help with student final projects. Scheduled meetings are also available upon request.
