For the catalog year 2008-2009, the Honors Program proposes the creation of the following suffixes for HPR 201 and HPR 202 Honors Colloquium:

- HPR 201A or 202A for general education credit in Fine Arts and Literature (A);
- HPR 201B or 202B for general education credit in Fine Arts and Literature **or** in Letters (A), or (L);
- HPR 201D or 202D for general education credit in Letters **or** in Social Science (L), or (S);
- HPR 201E or 202E for general education credit in Mathematical and Quantitative Reasoning **or** in Natural Science (MQ), or (N);
- HPR 201L or 202L for general education credit in Letters (L);
- HPR 201M or 202M for general education credit in Mathematical and Quantitative Reasoning (MQ);
- HPR 201N or 202N for general education credit in Natural Science (N);
- HPR 201S or 202S for general education credit in Social Science (S).

Rationale:

There is currently no easy way to determine the general education credit for the Honors Colloquium. For degree audits it is right now necessary to consult the catalog of the academic year in which a student has taken the colloquium because the credit awarded to the Colloquium changes. For example, in Fall 07 was approved for (FC) or (L), [D]; in Fall 06 for (L) or (S) [D]; and in Fall 08 it will most likely be approved for (N). Adding these suffixes will solve this problem, thus avoiding confusion among students and advisors and simplifying degree audits.
