



**Faculty Senate
University College and General Education Committee
Report #2006-07-2
Additions to the General Education Program**

The University College and General Education Committee considered the following courses during the fall 2006 semester and at their meeting of February 1, 2007. They are now presented to the Faculty Senate for confirmation.

I. Fine Arts and Literature (A) Core Area

The UCGE Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve the following course for the (A) area of the General Education program as follows:

SPA 320 Critical Studies in Spanish Cinema (*examining human differences, reading complex texts, writing effectively*)
Diversity

II. Foreign Language/Cross-cultural Competence (FC) Core Area

The UCGE Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve the following course for the (FC) area of the General Education program as follows:

SPA 320 Critical Studies in Spanish Cinema (*examining human differences, reading complex texts, writing effectively*)

III. Letters (L) Core Area

The UCGE Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve the following courses for the (L) area of the General Education program:

HIS 374 History of Modern China (*examining human differences, reading complex texts, writing effectively, using information technology*) Diversity

HIS 375 History of Modern Japan (*examining human differences, reading complex texts, writing effectively, using information technology*) Diversity

PHL 101 Critical Thinking (*reading complex texts, using qualitative data, using quantitative data*)

WMS 320 Feminist Thought into Action (*examining human differences, reading complex texts, writing effectively*) Diversity
