**University College and General Education Committee
Report #2006-07-4
Additions to the General Education Program**

The University College and General Education Committee considered the following matters at their meeting of April 5, 2007. They are now presented to the Faculty Senate for confirmation.

I. Fine Arts and Literature Core Area (A)

The UCGE Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve the following courses for the (A) core area of the General Education program:

ENG 262 Introduction to Literary Genres: Non-fiction (*examining human differences, reading complex texts, writing effectively*) Diversity

ENG 264 Introduction to Literary Genres: The Drama (*examining human differences, reading complex texts, writing effectively*) Diversity

ENG 265 Introduction to Literary Genres: The Novel (*examining human differences, reading complex texts, writing effectively*) Diversity

HPR 105 Honors Study in Fine Arts and Literature (at least three of the following: *examining human differences, reading complex texts, speaking effectively, writing effectively, using artistic activity*)

II. Foreign Language/Cross-cultural Competence Core Area (FC)

The UCGE Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve the following course for the (FC) core area of the General Education program:

HPR 201 for fall 07 Honors Colloquium - "China Rising: Honors Colloquium on Contemporary China" (*examining human differences, reading complex texts, writing effectively*) Diversity

III. Letters Core Area (L)

The UCGE Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve the following course for the (L) area of the General Education program:

HPR 201 for fall 07 Honors Colloquium - "China Rising: Honors Colloquium on Contemporary China" (*examining human differences, reading complex texts, writing effectively*) Diversity
