- **Established as Institute of Technology In Korea by the Presidential Decree in 1954**
- **10th & 11th President : Dr. Seoung-Yong Hong (2002~2009)**
- **University Structure: 10 Colleges, a Graduate School, 6 Professional Graduate Schools, Hospitals**
- **Multi-dimensional roles of Inha's alumni and teaching staff in industries, governments, and academia** (e.g. CEOs of Samsung Electronics and INI steels, Ministers, Ambassador, Secretaries to President, Korea)

- 15 - story building
