1. GU8 Student Contest

● The 1st GU8 Math Contest

- Host : Inha University (2009)
- Participants : 1 student from each university totaling 10
- Mathematics Competition modeling the International Mathematical Olympiad (2 days)
- Awards : 1st Prize : \$1,000 and medal
2nd Prize : \$500 and medal
3rd Prize : \$300 and medal



1. GU8 Student Contest

● Objectives

- Demonstrate and promote students' academic excellence
- Enhance awareness of and interest in joint education initiatives of the GU8

● Budget

- Round-trip airfare, accommodation and meals covered by host university
- To be annually hosted by member institutions in rotation

2. GU8 Summer Camps

● Program Details

- Any interested institutions can open their own summer camps (3~4 programs in initial year of 2009 including Inha University)
- Around 50 participants for each program
- A 2-week program with combined learning courses of lectures, cultural experiences, corporate visits, and opportunities for cross-cultural exchanges with multi-national students



2. GU8 Summer Camps

● Objectives

- Stimulate student mobility with an short, intensive program
- Lessen burden of time and money
- Encourage cross-cultural exchanges within GU8

● Budget

- Accommodation provided by host institution
- Airfare and tuition fees are at students' expenses

'08 INHA Summer School

● 2008 Summer School

- Specially customized for Japanese students with 29 students from Meiji University for this summer's program.
- Programs : Korean language, lecture series on Korean culture, Corporate visits (Korean Air, GM Daewoo), Field trips (DMZ, Andong Traditional Village), city tour to Incheon/ Seoul, tutoring and guidance by Korean buddy volunteer students
- To be expanded to students from all nationalities in 2009



'08 INHA Summer School

● Outlines

- Two-week intensive program designed to enhance understanding of the history, culture and dynamically changing society of Korea
- Opportunities for international students to mix and learn from each other through language/cultural exchanges

● Budget

- Tuition and program fees were waived
- Students were required to pay airfare, room and meals
(Dormitory fees : \$ 120 for two weeks)
- Total budget: \$ 25,000 (tuition, trips, receptions and etc.)

3. GU8 Faculty Exchange

● Structure

- EC (or Secretariat) centrally administers faculty exchange program
- Integrated application forms and procedures applied to all member universities
- Each member university posts information on the web such as period, salary, benefits, workload, fields and etc
- Interested professors and researchers can apply through website

3. GU8 Faculty Exchange

● Objectives

- Facilitate faculty exchange to encourage research collaboration and upgrade education quality mutually
- Make available all human resources while sabbatical leaves
- Provide standard format for faculty exchange within the GU8

● Conditions

- Each university tries to provide as good working conditions as possible within their budget and regulations
- Inha University will provide professors from the GU8 with the salary corresponding to local full-time faculty
