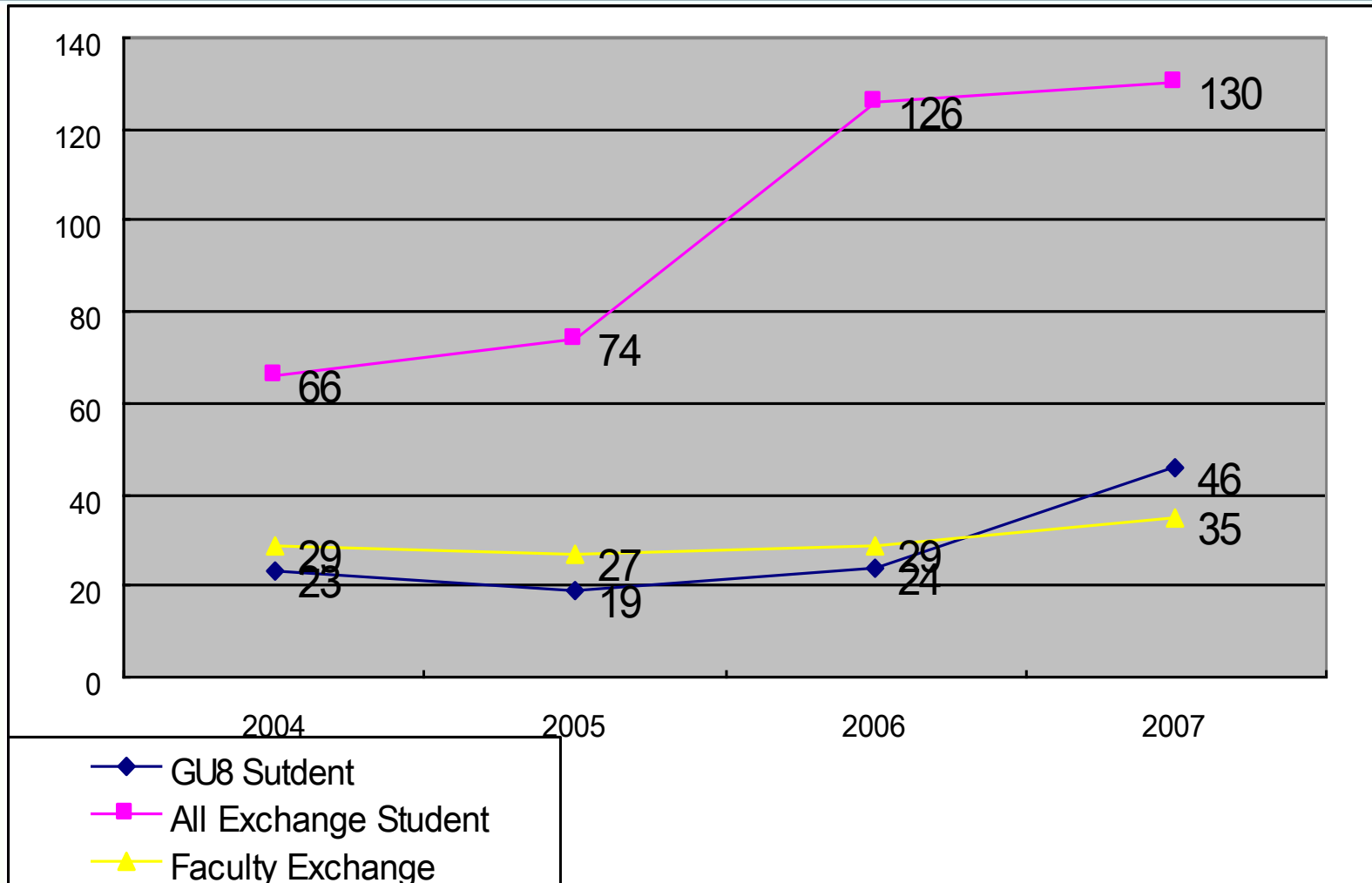

2. Student Exchange

Exchange Student in general

- * Students can study and acquire academic credits at foreign university for 1~2 semesters on a tuition waive/ reduction basis**
- * Inha University send all 160 exchange students to partner universities around the world annually**
- * Will send 200 students to 34 universities in 14 countries in 2007 (Including GU8 member universities)**

2. Student Exchange

Exchange Student with GU8

- * Exchange students with GU8 member universities based on the Education Committee recommendations and under the auspice of the Consortium (with **University of Rhode Island / Xiamen University / University of Le Havre / RMIT University**)
- * Will double the number of exchange students with **Xiamen University** from 2007
(10 ⇒ 20 annually on a tuition waiver basis)
- * Will start exchanging students with **Meiji University** beginning 2008
(10 students including 3 tuition-free students)
- * New Student Exchange Agreement to be signed with **University of Haifa**
(10 students including 3 tuition-free students)

2. Student Exchange

GU8 Double Degree Program

- **3+1 Double Degree in Logistics (Inha + RMIT)**
 - Articulation Arrangement signed in August 2006
 - Inha students to be admitted to RMIT's Logistics and Supply Chain Management program
 - 3 years at Inha + 1 years at RMIT
(2 years of study and internship completed at Inha to be recognized at RMIT)
 - Two degrees will be issued from two universities upon successful completion of study course
 - One student will start study at RMIT this fall semester

2. Student Exchange

GU8 Double Degree Program

- Double degree of graduate 1.5+0.5 programs on **Marine Affairs** among Inha, URI and Xiamen
- Global Master of Business Administration** (Global MBA) program among Inha, URI, Le Havre and Xiamen
- Double degree of undergraduate program on Engineering between Inha and URI

MGLM Scholarship

* Master of Global Logistics Management program at Inha's Graduate School of Logistics (18 months Modular Program)

* All classes are taught in English by foreign professors invited from abroad

* Inha offers to provide **scholarship for one student from each member university**

Annual Faculty Exchange Program with Le Havre

- Inha and Le Havre exchange professors annually for two weeks for lecture and research collaboration

- DUO-Korea Fellowship : 2 teams in 2004 and 2005
- STAR Program : 2~3 teams successful annually

Master of Global Logistics Management (MGLM)

*** Given in English by fourteen professors drawn from ten universities in Asia, Australian, Europe and North America and resident faculty from Inha University**

*** Visited 2 professors from RMIT and URI and Will visit 5 professors from Le Havre, UW, RMIT and URI to have a lecture for Supply Chain Management, Business and Global Logistics**

Global MBA Program

*** Inha, URI, Xiamen and Le Havre start the intensive 6 week courses - two weeks in each institution for global MBA program**

4. Suggestions

For Student Exchange

- Continue exchange student program beyond the initial three (3) year period as agreed in 2005
- Increase the number and open the opportunities to more students
- Include the associate member universities
- Assign the contact person for each university for prompt and efficient communication
- Ease the application process and documentation by providing one-stop service and online application system
- Arrange an annual meeting between staff of student exchange programs to negotiate the number and discuss details of exchange

4. Suggestions

For Faculty Exchange

- Expand the annual faculty exchange program to other member universities
- Share information on outside funding programs for international exchange
(ex: DUO-Korea program, Government programs)
- Promote the joint GUS conferences among professors to activate more participation
- International Conference on Fusion Technology in June 2007 at La Havre
- Workshop on Nanotechnology at Xiamen, Business History and Marine Affairs at URI in 2007
- Distribute information on academic seminars and conferences to be held at each university
- Promote exchange of young researchers and Ph.D. students to upgrade research capability and attract young potential talents
