Udall Scholarship Pre-Application Info For URI Students

- Eligibility Criteria:
 - Currently a Sophomore or Junior
 - Students who have demonstrated commitment to careers related to the environment; **or**

Native American and Alaska Native students who have demonstrated commitment to careers: related to tribal public policy **or** to Native health care
 - Be pursuing full-time study during the 2012-2013 academic year
 - Be a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or U.S. permanent resident
 - A GPA \geq 3.8
- The internal pre-application is due on **January 12th by 4pm**. Please email the entire pre-application (see below) as a PDF to kmaher@uri.edu and jamador@uri.edu
- The pre-application **must include** the following:
 1. A filled-out, electronic version of the SAMPLE application, which may be downloaded from the Udall web site (www.udall.gov)
 2. An unofficial college transcript (from e-Campus)
 3. List of three individuals who, if you are nominated, will provide letters of reference. Along with their name and title, please provide a brief statement as to their relevance to your Udall nomination. (i.e. What can each recommender speak to in his/her letter that will help make your case as a great fit for the Udall Scholarship?)
- What the pre-application **does not need** to include:
 1. Official college and high school transcripts
 2. The 800-word essay discussing one of Udall's acts, speeches or policy statements
 3. Letters of recommendation
- You will be notified of the URI nominating committee's decision by January 20th. If nominated your 800-word essay and letters of recommendation must be received by the secondary campus deadline of February 10th, 2012. You will then work with Prof. Amador and Ms. Maher on perfecting your essays and submitting the official online application.
