Paul I. Abell Memorial Honors Student Award

The Abell award provides financial support to deserving students in the Honors Program. Examples of eligible uses include expenses related to an Honors Senior Project; travel expenses for research; attending a conference or other meaningful event; research expenses and/or materials related to any particular course; or any other purpose as determined by the Honors Program Director. Special consideration will be given to students working in anthropology or the study of ancient cultures.

Awards generally will be made up to an amount not to exceed \$300.

Applications should be submitted to the Honors Director in the Honors Program Office in Lippitt Hall, 300A or 300B.

Applications should include

- a 1-2 page description of your project, including its importance in general and its importance to you. This should include a paragraph explaining how this is a project related to anthropology or ancient cultures, if relevant.
- a statement of 1 page or less on your preparation to do this project. This may include descriptions of courses you have taken and experiences you have had.
- a budget stating the total amount of the grant you are requesting up to \$300 and itemizing your expected expenses.
