

Receive funding for your Senior Honors Project!

**Joan Irvine Smith and Athalie R. Clark
Award for Environmental Research**

The Smith-Clark scholarship provides financial support to honors students doing research that involves studying ways to preserve and protect the environment and improve the quality of life.

Preference will be given to research related to understanding, protecting, or preserving the coastal, marine, and/or freshwater environments but all students doing research with an environmental focus are eligible.

Awards will be made up to an amount not to exceed \$400, and they will be made to Juniors and Seniors working on environmental projects during Spring 2010.

Applications should be submitted to Professor McIntyre in the Honors Program Office in Lippitt Hall, 300A or 300B, by the *deadline of Friday, December 4, 2009.*

Applications should include

- a 1-2 page description of your senior honors project research, including its importance in general and its importance to you. This should include a paragraph explaining how this is an environmental project.
- a statement of 1 page or less on your preparation to do this project. This may include descriptions of courses you have taken and experiences you have had.
- a budget stating the total amount of the grant you are requesting up to \$400 and itemizing your expected expenses.
