Eric F. Kumpf Memorial Humanities Honors Student Endowment

The Kumpf scholarship provides financial support to students doing Senior Honors Projects in the Humanities. These are projects in History, Philosophy, Literature or the Social Sciences that explore how ideas about the human experience are expressed and interpreted, as well as Arts projects that explore the creative process.

Awards will be made up to an amount not to exceed \$400, and they will be made to students working on projects in the Humanities during Spring 2009.

Applications should be submitted to the Honors Director in the Honors Program Office in Lippitt Hall, 300A or 300B, by the *deadline of Wednesday, November 25, 2009.*

Applications should include

- a 1-2 page description of your senior honors project research, including its importance in general and its importance to you. This should include a paragraph explaining how this is a Humanities project.
- a statement of 1 page or less on your preparation to do this project. This may include descriptions of courses you have taken and experiences you have had.
- a budget stating the total amount of the grant you are requesting up to \$400 and itemizing your expected expenses.
