

Honors Opportunity Fund

The **Honors Opportunity Fund** provides financial support to deserving students who, as part of their honors program study or activity, incur unusual financial expenses. Examples of eligible uses include expenses related to an Honors Senior Project; expenses for research or meaningful academic activities related to any particular honors course; or any other purpose as determined by the Honors Program Director.

Applications should include:

1. a 1-2 page description of your project or activity, including its importance in general and its importance to you.
2. a statement of 1 page or less on your preparation to do this project. This may include descriptions of courses you have taken and experiences you have had.
3. a budget stating the total amount of the grant you are requesting up to \$500.00 and itemizing your expected expenses.
4. An itemization of any other funds you have received or have applied for from any other sources related to this project
5. a brief one page resume

If you wish, you are also welcome to submit a letter of support from a faculty member who is familiar with your work.

All applications are to be submitted to the Director of the Honors Program, Lippitt 300. Deadline is December 11, 2009.
