What are the Praxis™ tests? Which tests should I take?

The Praxis Series™ assessments include the Praxis I® Pre-Professional Skills Tests and Praxis II® Subject Assessments.

The Praxis I tests measure basic academic skills in reading, writing and mathematics. They are usually required by either state licensing agencies or institutions of higher education prior to entry into teacher preparation programs.

The Praxis II tests measure subject-specific knowledge and pedagogical knowledge and are required for licensure or certification by many states and national organizations.

For specific test requirements, please see the Praxis™ website at www.ets.org/praxis/states. **Test takers should check directly with their state or certification agency to confirm which tests they must take, because these requirements are often complex and subject to frequent change.**

When are the tests given?

Some Praxis tests are offered in a computer-delivered format and are given by appointment. Please see www.ets.org/praxis/register for further information on registering for and scheduling a computer-delivered test. Praxis tests that are offered in a paper-delivered format are offered on fixed dates throughout the year. Please see the table below for test dates and deadlines. What are the fees associated with taking the Praxis™ tests?

Fees for computer-delivered and paper-delivered *Praxis* tests differ depending on the type and length of test you are taking. Please visit <http://www.ets.org/praxis/about/fees> for details.

ETS has been asked by Nevada to collect a \$5 surcharge (per test) from individuals testing at Nevada test centers.

How do I register?

Computer-Delivered Tests: Register online for computer-delivered *Praxis* tests using a credit or debit card, at www.ets.org/praxis/register/computer or call Prometric Candidate Services at **1-800-853-6773**. A list of test centers is available on the *Praxis* website. To register and pay by check or money order, download and complete the Computer-Delivered Test Authorization Voucher Request form and submit it to the address on the form with payment. The Computer-Delivered Test Authorization Voucher can be found at www.ets.org/praxis/cdtvoucher.

Paper-Delivered Tests: Register online for paper-delivered *Praxis* tests using a credit or debit card. To register and pay by check or money order, download and complete the *Praxis* Paper-Delivered Test Registration Form and submit it to the address on the form with payment. Additional information on registration can be found at www.ets.org/praxis/register/paper.

Emergency registration is available for an additional fee to test takers who have missed the regular and extended registration deadlines. This service is only available online. See the schedule on the front page of this flyer for emergency registration deadlines.

Note: Some states require a Social Security Number (SSN) in order to process teacher certification paperwork. Check your state's requirements page at www.ets.org/praxis/states to see if your state requires a SSN with your test score reports. ETS does not require your SSN for its own purposes but will submit it to your state agency with your test results. **Failure to provide your SSN could delay your state's processing of your certification application.**

Are special accommodations available if required by the test taker?

The following accommodations are available: extended time for test takers whose primary language is not English, Monday testing for test takers whose military service or religious convictions prevent testing on Saturday, and nonstandard testing accommodations for test takers with documented disabilities. **Consult the *Information Bulletin*, available online at www.ets.org/praxis/about/bulletin, for additional information regarding what's required to qualify.**

What should I know about Identification (ID) requirements?

Valid Identification (ID) with **name, signature and photograph** is required for admission to a test center. ID requirements are strictly enforced. Your name on your ID must be exactly the same as the name you provided when you registered. If your primary ID is missing either a photo or a signature, you must present a supplemental ID in addition to your primary ID. What should I know about electronic devices?

Cell phones, BlackBerry® devices, PDAs and any other electronic or photographic devices are not permitted at the test center. If you bring such devices to the test center, you will be dismissed from the test, your registration and test fees will be forfeited and your scores will be canceled. If you are seen USING such a device, in addition to the above conditions, the device will be confiscated and inspected. Test center staff are not permitted to collect or store devices.

What if I need to cancel or reschedule my test prior to my test date?

Computer-Delivered Tests: You may cancel or reschedule your computer-delivered test online or by calling the appropriate test center or Prometric Candidate Services no later than three full days prior to your appointment. You can request a refund by submitting a Refund Request Form to ETS. **If you do not cancel within the appropriate time frame, your test fee will be forfeited.** To cancel or reschedule online, go to the online registration link on the *Praxis* website at www.ets.org/praxis/register/changes/.

Paper-Delivered Tests: To cancel and request a refund, submit a Refund Request Form to ETS. The form must be received **no later than three full days prior to your test date.** Please note that registration fees are nonrefundable.

When will I receive my scores?

Computer-Delivered Tests: Official scores will be available by web 10 – 15 days after you take the test for most test titles. Scores for tests given during a specific testing window will be available by web 10 – 15 days after the testing window closes (regardless of the specific day on which you tested within that window). You can view your unofficial multiple-choice scores for certain tests at the test center. Because of the scoring process for constructed-response questions, your scores for tests containing constructed-response questions will not be available at the test center.

Paper-Delivered Tests: Your score report will be available by web on the score reporting dates shown on the first page of this flyer. Online scores are downloadable and available for 45 calendar days from the score reporting date. If you wish to obtain your scores earlier, you may use the Scores by Phone service for an additional fee. Additional Score Reports (ASRs): ASRs are available for a fee. Complete your request online or download and complete the ASR request form located on the *Praxis* website at www.ets.org/praxis/asr.

What if I need to cancel my scores?

Computer-Delivered Tests: You may cancel your scores on a computer-delivered test by following the instructions at the end of each test. If you are taking the combined PPST test and choose to cancel your scores, scores from all three sections will be canceled. Once you have viewed your scores, they cannot be canceled. Canceled scores cannot be reinstated. You will not receive a refund if you cancel your scores.

Paper-Delivered Tests: Download and complete the Request for Score Cancellation form located at www.ets.org/praxis/about/bulletin. **The form must be received by ETS no later than seven days after your test date.** You will not receive a refund if you choose to cancel your score. Canceled scores will not be reported nor will they be reinstated.
