

Assessment for Beginning Teacher Dispositions

Directions for students: Physical and Health Education Teacher Education students should, as part of their portfolio requirements for Diversity & Dispositions, provide three dispositional reference forms from professors of the following courses: KIN 116, KIN 117, KIN 118, KIN 120, KIN 270, KIN 369, or KIN 278, if applicable. (Section III of the portfolio).

Please note, only ask professors or instructors with whom you have completed a course to fill out a disposition form. If you are currently in the class with a professor or instructor, please do not ask him/her to fill out a form as he/she would have potentially known you for 2 weeks or less and could not give a reasonable assessment on your dispositions.

Directions for URI faculty: Please take the time to complete this form (found on the next page) using the following guidelines in assigning a score:

- 5** Consistently demonstrates this behavior and models and encourages others to do so.
Leads classmates and behaves at the level of an experienced professional
- 4** Always demonstrates this behavior; mature traits/behaviors
- 3** Consistently demonstrates this behavior at or slightly above level of most of his/her colleagues.
- 2** Occasionally demonstrates behavior-has room for improvement
- 1** Failure to demonstrate responsible and respectful behavior—needs correction and reflection with respect to the effects and consequences of this behavior
- NA** Not applicable
