

## KINESIOLOGY ADVISORS 2011 – 2012

Every Kinesiology student has an advisor. It is the student's responsibility to understand 1) how the advising system works; 2) if they are in University College or the College of Human Science and Services / Kinesiology Department; and 3) how to make an appointment with their advisor.

### University College

- You are in University College (UC) if you: 1) have less than 24 credits; 2) have not passed BIO 101; or 3) have not passed BIO 121
- Appointments should be made on-line through the UC web page
- Kinesiology representatives for Fall 2010 are: Professor Penny Steen and Ms. Stephanie Champlin
- Students should strive to transfer out of UC and into the College of Human Science and Services/Kinesiology Department by the end of their third semester.
- Kinesiology advisors in UC often change each semester. You will have a departmental advisor when you transfer out of UC (you must pass BIO 101 and receive a C or better in BIO 121)

### Kinesiology Department

- Students who have been transferred out of UC and into the College of Human Science and Services/Kinesiology Department should **not** make appointments on-line through the University College web site
- Students should directly contact their advisor (listed below) to schedule an appointment. This can be done in person, by phone or by e-mail
- Refer to your unofficial transcript, which you can access through e-campus, to find out if you are in UC or Kinesiology. Look at the most current semester to find your standing.
