

# Summer Housing at the Heidi Kirk Duffy Center (IEP & TI Houses)

AVAILABLE MAY 23 - AUGUST 31, 2011

Double room: \$500/month per person      Single room: \$600/month

**Per diem lodging is available** at a rate of \$20/night in a single and \$15/night in a double (per diem rates are for a maximum of 3 weeks).

Price also includes: URI internet, WiFi, URI cable, air conditioning, laundry facilities, and access to a refrigerator, toaster, microwave oven, coffee maker, treadmill, exercise bike, outdoor picnic tables, deck and patio, and convenient parking.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** There will be a special discount given to those who have lived or will live at the Heidi Kirk Duffy Center for 2 consecutive semesters. The discounted rates are: **\$400/month per person for a double room and \$500/month for a single room.** Please inquire about this special discount.

**Meals are not included in this rate, as the kitchen will be closed for most of the summer.** The kitchen is not available for private use.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The IEP & TI Houses operate on an honor system and will limit summer housing to residents who will adhere to its values and goals. *Please review the attached Statement of Purpose, Lodging Agreement and Rules and Regulations prior to proceeding.*

**Priority will be given to students in the International Engineering Program and affiliated exchange students.** Applicants will be considered on a case-by-case basis, but in general all summer residents are expected to meet one of the following eligibility requirements:

- Students taking URI summer classes.
- Students employed by URI for the summer or engaged in a local internship.
- Graduate students performing research and/or thesis/dissertation work.
- Students with other local employment whose primary residence is out-of-state.
- International Scholars/Visitors sponsored by a URI department or program.

A deposit of \$100, which will be applied toward the last week of residence, must be paid at the time of application. The deposit is non-refundable unless residency is denied.

SPACE IS LIMITED. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO RESERVE A ROOM, PLEASE SIGN AGREEMENT AND SUBMIT A \$100 DEPOSIT TO THE IEP OFFICE. **Preference will be given to applications received by May 16th.** (Spaces may be free after the 1<sup>st</sup>, on a first-come availability basis.)

## International Engineering Program House Statement of Purpose

The IEP & TI Houses are the administrative and residential center founded to support the goals and activities of the International Engineering Program. It is a home for students, from the U. S. and abroad, seeking to prepare themselves for leadership careers in the contemporary global workplace. It provides a partnership among faculty, students, and all persons in the public and private sectors who are committed to the goals of a global technical education.

The IEP & TI Houses are a model for responsible residential living, based on the philosophy that students with similar academic and career goals, regardless of their national background, race, or creed, will be supportive of each other and benefit mutually in a common living environment.

A model for interaction between higher education and practitioners in the global workplace, the International Engineering Program was established in response to the needs of a changing world. The IEP & TI Houses exemplify the manner in which educators and members of the private sector may work together in supporting young persons preparing for a complex world.

\_\_\_\_ 1. I have read and concur with the IEP & TI Houses Statement of Purpose. I understand that the IEP & TI Houses are honors facilities with high standards of behavior and academic expectations. As a resident in the IEP & TI Houses, I pledge to maintain these goals and standards.

\_\_\_\_ 2. I have read the rules and regulations for the IEP & TI Houses on the reverse side and will abide by them and encourage fellow residents to do the same.

\_\_\_\_ 3. I am a student or scholar at the University of Rhode Island.

\_\_\_\_ 4. I understand that the IEP & TI Houses are self-sustaining and self-governing. I will actively support the programs of the house and will share actively in keeping the house clean and in good order.

\_\_\_\_ 5. I am submitting a non-refundable deposit of \$100 to reserve a room from \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ and agree to pay the monthly balance **on the first of each month**. This deposit will be applied toward my final week of residence.

\_\_\_\_ 7. I understand the meals are **NOT** included in the rent, but that I may purchase meals for \$4 (breakfast,) \$7 (lunch), \$9 (dinner) when the kitchen is open to the public, M-F, in late August.

## **Rules and Regulations**

### **House Care**

All students are responsible for the care of their rooms and the general upkeep of the houses. If a resident(s) or their guest(s) causes damage, the resident(s) will be billed for repairs. Damages include, but are not limited to, holes in the walls, burns, scratches, stains, broken furniture, etc.

### **Noise**

The IEP & TI Houses are the administrative center for the International Engineering Program as well as a place of residence. Be respectful of others needs by keeping noise at reasonable levels. Close doors and do not loiter in the hallways.

### **Guests**

Guests are allowed as long as they do not infringe upon the rights of residents. Residents are responsible for their guests and any action or disturbance caused by a guest will be considered an action or disturbance caused by the resident. The International Engineering Program staff holds the right to ask any guest to leave and/or not return.

Overnight guests are permitted, with your roommate's permission, for a maximum of three nights. You must register your guest with the IEP Office if they are staying longer than one night. Guests must pay for any food consumed in the dining room at posted rates.

### **Alcohol Policy**

Rhode Island law prohibits the consumption of alcoholic beverages by persons under the age of 21. The consumption of alcohol or possession of an open container of alcohol is prohibited in any area outside of a student's room.

### **Drug Policy**

The use of any illegal drug in the house is strictly forbidden. If a resident or his/her guest uses or possesses any illegal drug in the house or on the International Engineering Program House(s) property, that resident will be evicted and his/her rent will be forfeited.

### **Firearms and Fireworks are Strictly Prohibited.**

### **Pets**

No animals or pets, with the exception of fish in properly maintained aquariums of 20 gallons or less, are permitted in the house.

### **Smoking**

Smoking is prohibited from all areas inside the house.

### **Security**

All residents are expected to take reasonable measures to protect their own property by locking their room door and exclusively retaining their assigned keys. Outside doors must remain securely closed at all times. The University and the International Engineering Program do not take any responsibility for personal items.

With the exception of the penalty for the drug policy described above, all other violations will be noted and repeat offenses can result in further action.

### **IEP & TI Houses Disciplinary Agreement.**

I have read, fully understand and agree with the above policies. I am aware that any infraction of these policies can result in disciplinary action. The IEP & TI Houses reserve the right to evict violators of house policies.
