



PROGRAM A: Intensive Undergraduate Program

Placement: All students take a placement exam to determine their level. Students who place above intermediate level may take up to nine credits, six of which will be language credits. For example, a student who places higher than **Spanish 104** (intermediate II), may enroll in SPA 310 for one, two or three additional credits.
