

The Voluntary System of Accountability (VSA) reports results from a single-question survey of graduating seniors about their immediate future plans.

An email survey was conducted from April 23 through May 17, 2009.

Of 1734 email requests sent out to undergraduates receiving degrees this spring, 1620 (94.3%) of the messages were delivered and 114 (6.6%) were undeliverable.

A total of 953 individuals (59.4% of recipients of the request to participate) opened the email and 212 (22.0 %) recipients responded.

In response to the question, “**What is MOST LIKELY to be your PRINCIPAL activity upon graduation?**” answers were distributed as follows:
