Please Note:

- Graduate Students should anticipate costs of about \$1,500 for "settling-in."
- Undergraduate students in residence halls should plan to bring about \$700 for bedding, rugs, lamps, and so on.
- **Bank drafts** clear in 4-6 weeks. Plan to bring adequate funds in travelers' checks (US dollars). This is extremely important, as no emergency funds are available to help students who run into financial difficulty.
