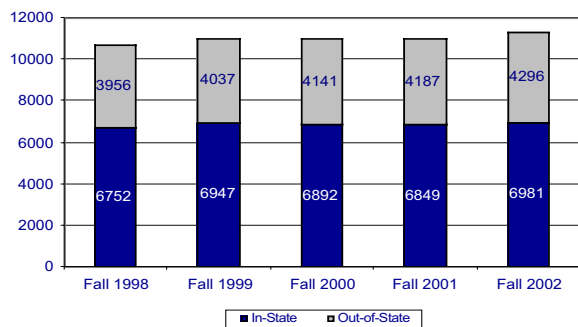

Undergraduate Enrollment

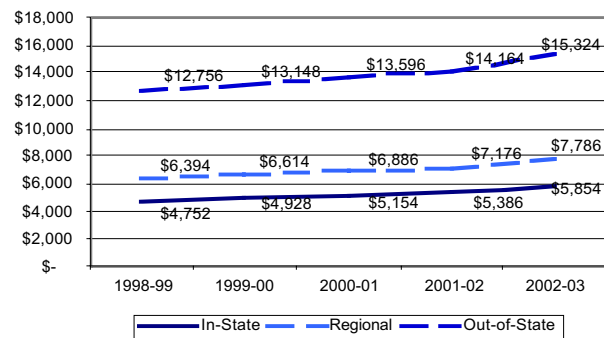
Fall 1998 – 2002

1998-99 through 2002-03

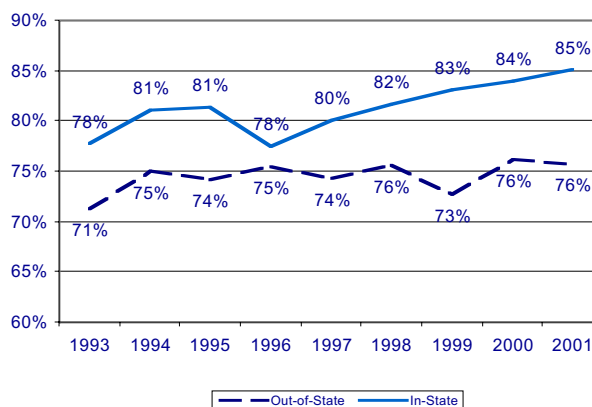


2002 Freshman Class Profile

- Multicultural students 12%

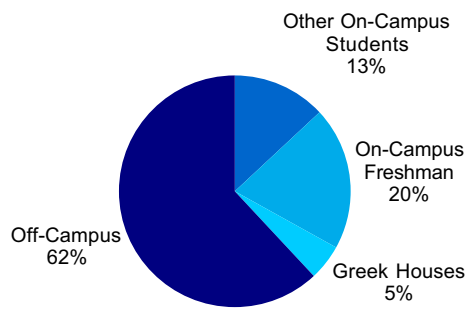
One-Year Retention Rates for Freshman

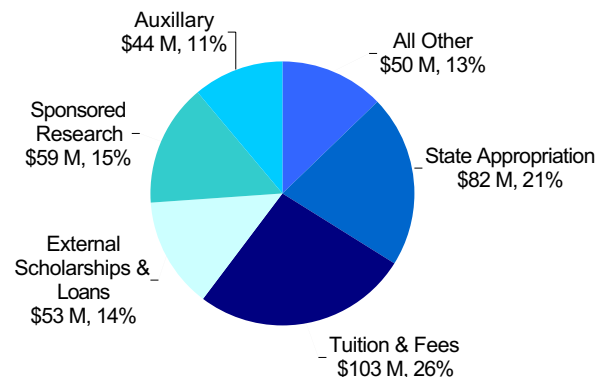

Construction Highlights

Grand Openings or Reopenings

- **Ryan Center** (Opened June 2002)
- **Boss Ice Arena** (Opened September 2002)
- **Chafee Social Science Center** (Reopened Fall 2002 following temporary closure in December 2000)
- **Green Hall** (Restored and reopened February 2003) Houses the offices of the President, Provost, and Enrollment Services. Official Open House May 30, 2003.
- **Women's Center** (Community open house held March 2003) Official Open House September 2003.
- **Ballentine Hall** (Grand reopening June 2003)
- **Residential Life** The \$64 million, seven-year residence hall renovation project has made steady progress. The largest residence, the 300-bed Browning Hall, will reopen for Sept. 2003. Completed are: Barlow Hall (Aug. '00), Weldin Hall (Jan. '01), Bressler Hall (Sept. '01), Butterfield Hall (Jan. 2002), and renovations of Butterfield Dining Hall.

On the Horizon

- **Lippitt and Independence Halls** (Planning and design work in progress)
- **Exterior elements** of the "Freshmen Village," a neighborhood of six newly renovated residence halls, will be completed during the summer of 2003.
- **On-campus** apartment-style housing options for juniors and seniors. (Planning under way.)
