Presently at Milford Regional Medical Center there are 4 Internal Medicine Residency teams, each consisting of 1 Junior or Senior Resident, 1 Intern and, at various times, 1 Medical Student (either 3rd year or 4th year). One team each day is the “On Call” team and is responsible for admitting all patients that day.

The following is an example of some of the activities that a Pharm.D. student will participate in:

7:30-9:30 am: Patient Rounds

11:30AM-12:30PM Morning Report – presentation and discussion of specific patient cases by one of the Residents or Chief Resident.

On Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays

10:30-12:00 N Attending MD Teaching Rounds – A “Teaching Attending” MD for the month discusses a disease state and its treatment.

On Mondays and Wednesdays

12N-1:00 pm: Noon Conference – A Specialist discusses topics pertinent to his practice of medicine.

Optional (Daily):

12N-1:30 pm Radiology Rounds – Radiologists discuss the findings/impressions specific patient X-rays

1:30 pm:-? Medical Library: The Director of the Medical Library is available to assist students with literature searches, Internet usage, audiovisual equipment usage, Interlibrary loans etc. The Medical Library has a small number of journals and medical textbooks on-site which the students are allowed to borrow. A more comprehensive list of journals is available in off-site storage due to a reduction in library space.

Students have an opportunity to view a surgical case in the Operating Room and/or ride with the Milford Regional Medical Center Paramedics Team for a day.
