



### ***EXPERIENTIAL PROGRAMS***

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**Site Description Information:** The practice site at Caritas Good Samaritan Medical Center (CGSMC) is a 221-bed acute care teaching hospital located approximately 20 miles south of Boston. CGSMC provides care to patients in critical care, oncology, geriatrics, maternity, special care nursery. Orthopedics and nephrology. The facility is a teaching hospital for surgical residents.

**Student Activities:** While on site, students can expect to work with clinical pharmacy staff in a variety of patient care areas. Our PharmD candidates participate in surgical, critical care, geriatric psychiatry and pain management rounds. Students are involved in: IV to PO conversions, Renal dosing, adverse drug reaction (ADR) reporting, discharge counseling, DVT prophylaxis, pediatric dosing review and other clinical programs such as High Dose Aminoglycosides & Vancomycin management, Weight-Based Heparin dosing and IV room activities. Students may also have the opportunity to observe surgical procedures upon request.

**Goals/Objectives:** To provide all pharmacy students with clinical experience in interdisciplinary rounds, ADR reporting, patient counseling, and various clinical activities. Students will also expand knowledge of multiple disease states through presentations and by attending CME programs.

**Projects and/or required activities:**

- Daily Rounds – Surgical, Critical Care and GeroPsych
- Daily Reports – IV to PO, Renal Dosing, DVT Prophylaxis reports
- Discharge Counseling
- Adverse Drug Reaction reporting
- Presentations – 2 Live (ppt & paper) Disease state and/or Case presentation
- Paper – 1 paper 2-5 pages (topic assigned)
- IV room activities – TPN, etc.
