Rotation Description

Location: St. Luke’s Hospital – Bethlehem Campus

Site Description Information: St. Luke’s Hospital Network at Bethlehem Campus, Pennsylvania is a 436 bed hospital devoted to the community as a tertiary care facility. The institution provides many services including cardiology, emergency medicine, family medicine, internal medicine, mental health, neonatology, cardiovascular surgery, pediatrics, and trauma. Activities of the critical care rotation will occur on site. The student has to be flexible, independent, and self motivated. It is advised that the student has had a medicine rotation prior. Also, the student has to provide his/her own transportation and accommodations.
