The adult ambulatory care rotation is a part time rotation centered around an adult internal medicine clinic affiliated with Maine Medical Center. Patients of the clinic are served primarily by resident physicians and nurse practitioners with oversight from attending physicians. The student will be involved in regular review of patient charts for pharmacy related issues, participation in teaching rounds, policy and procedure review as it related to an outpatient unit, exposure to the pharmacy and therapeutics committee, etc. A strong emphasis will be placed on the monitoring and education of diabetic patients. Preventative care as well as urgent care needs will be reviewed. Upon completion of the rotation, the student will have an understanding of the role of a clinical pharmacist in the outpatient arena. They will be able to review a patient chart and formulate a pharmaceutical care plan for the patient and be able to present the recommendations in both the written and verbal format.
