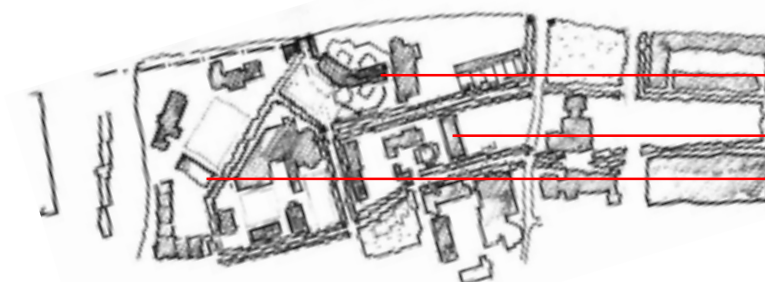




Group 1

The initial focus of the group (after parking) was the creation of a new quad for the Sustainable Communities Building around what is now the Learning Landscape Garden. This set up a relationship with the fine arts building and reinforced a proposal to connect from the quad *through* the fine arts entrance expanding its lobby and making it more public, possibly with a cafe. The “nice walk” along the north and south of the garden “quad” continued to the west, suggesting a wide boulevard organization that terminates or transforms it as it encounters the rotated biotech and pharmacy quads. The Pharmacy quad used the rotated geometry of nursing school and an addition to the Biological Science building to form a major rotated quad. A new “off-site” parking deck to the west was felt to be a better location to allow housing into the south edge of the north district and to connect the district better with the other residence halls.
