Group 2 proposed to reinforce and strengthen the identity of three sciences currently represented on the North campus - Environmental, Biological, and Health - by grouping new and existing buildings with related programs and creating clearly defined quadrangles for each. The character of each quadrangle would, through the use of plants, sculpture, etc., be unique and representative of the science being studied within the buildings fronting each space.

The quadrangles are to be linked by a pedestrian path designed to also accommodate service vehicles. A "wetlands walk" would provide other linkages within the precinct by reconnecting areas of existing water and vegetation. Student housing together with structured parking is proposed as anchors to both the east and west ends of the precinct - destinations that will provide a greater level of activity within the area throughout the day. Alumni Drive will be closed to vehicular traffic (except service and emergency vehicles). Upper Campus Road is also proposed as closed to traffic, allowing the existing garden area to extend eastward to include the Fine Arts courtyard. A café and gallery space were proposed in Fine Arts to strengthen the arts presence and encourage interaction between all students, faculty and staff in the area.
