An east-west "Alumni Walk" pedestrian thoroughfare crisscrosses a watered green swath and intersects a strong north-south connection from the URI main quad to Flagg Road. The Alumni Walk southern edge to Noth Campus is paired by a green buffer along the northern edge of the site to simultaneously announce entry to North Campus and sustain varied plant and animal species. Three planned buildings, Sustainable Communities, Pharmacy and Biotech, are located to form new quads that engage existing North Campus buildings. Additionally, a mixed-use parking, small commercial and student community building is proposed on the western edge of North Campus as a social condenser.
