

### **How to answer proposal question on E.O. 12372:**

- Look in your RFP, it may say whether it is subject to E.O. 12372
- If your proposal will be submitted through Cayuse, you may see something about how to answer the question in your Errors/Warnings/Info bar (bottom of proposal).
- If neither of those two options tell you how to answer the question, you can look at the list of Rhode Island's waived opportunities at:
