

The Christopher House Slate Campaign



The Christopher House is the former home of a University Professor and over the years has grown into a symbol for the fraternity and sorority community at URI. We have taken over the Christopher House for use as the headquarters for the Greek community at the University of Rhode Island. Greek students now have a common place in addition to chapter houses, to meet, plan, relax, and work together. The Christopher House is an ideal place for community-wide teambuilding and gives our fraternities and sororities greater visibility and campus recognition. The Christopher House has become a daily meeting point for URI Greek leaders and members.

Over the past year, with the help of many donations, the Christopher House has been renovated almost in its entirety. One of the next steps in the renovation process is to landscape the outside of the property. Rather than simply asking for donation, we would like to invite each Greek member, parent, alumni, or supporter to own a piece of the Christopher House and the legacy that has become the URI Greek community.

We are selling engraved slate, which will be used to build a walkway in front of the Christopher House. The slate can be ordered in honor of a student, alumnus, or organization, as a graduation gift, or for whatever purpose you wish. The slate can be engraved as you wish. The slate donation is \$100.00 for a 6 inch by 9 inch slate with engraving included, or \$250 for a 12 inch by 12 inch slate with engraving included. The donation made to the Christopher House Campaign is tax-deductible. **The deadline to place your order is approaching soon!**

Please Note: The slate campaign is a one time only offer. Because of the preparation work that needs to be done to the ground where the slate walkway will be built prior to the actual building of the walkway, we will not be able to add to the slate walkway in the future. **This campaign will be run this year only.** If you are thinking of purchasing a piece of slate at the Christopher House in the future, you must do it now.
