Type of Services: Adults and pediatrics, including treatment of illness and prevention of disease through screening tests, immunizations, nutritional advice, and follow-up care. Pregnancy testing, gynecologic exams and family planning. Center also offers Dental Care, and Social Services, laboratory and x-ray done on site, WIC (Women, Infants & Children Program) and Nutrition.

Fees: Sliding-scale fee upon request – depends on income and family size. URI student health insurance is accepted.
