

URITC – RITEA Robotics Competition Poster Exhibit

Some Guidelines for the Poster Exhibit:

- Your poster exhibit should be presented on a standard 3-fold Science Fair Backboard
- The poster should represent research on any topic of **Occupations in Transportation**. (Pick an occupation and research it)
- There will not be any verbal presentation, so your poster should be a complete visual representation of all your research. (Do not attach research reports)
- If you do have any models that are not attached to the poster they need to fit in the small angled space in front of the board.
- All posters will be left at URI for display at the National Transportation Week Breakfast. Any models must also be left with the poster.
- The work should be of the highest quality – visually pleasing and interesting as well as easy to read and understand.
- You will be judged by your peers, coaches, and invited guests.

Judging of the Poster Exhibits will be as follows:

- Each team will be given a different color Lego Brick
- There will be a viewing time to view all 15 poster exhibits.
- Each person will be allowed to cast one vote into the box of the team they felt had the best exhibit.
- No team can vote for themselves. (These votes will be disqualified)
- Your vote should be a thoughtful decision based on what you feel is the very best poster representing some aspect of transportation in R.I. (Besides your own of course)
- Awards will be given to the teams that have the three most votes.
